- For currently enrolled students who do not register online, signed Registration Forms can be turned in starting on February 20, 2023 from 8:00 am- 4:00 pm in Room 628. Graduate Registration Forms are to be submitted to Room 626. The forms will be numbered as they are turned in and registration will occur in numerical order.
- Incoming Fall J1 students wishing to enroll in 314 Pharmacology or incoming Graduate students wishing to enroll in courses for summer will complete registration forms and completed registration forms are submitted to room 628 starting February 13, 2023.

**Walk-in Summer Registration available from February 20 – May 19, 2023, 8:00 am-4:00 pm, or until all classes are closed to registrations.**

#### **Registration and Student Account Implications:**

- To assure timely receipt of billing statements and to allow time needed to complete financial arrangements, please register as early as possible.
- Student Account payment is ***due 30 days prior to semester start*** (Due date for Summer 2023 semester is April 21, 2023)
- Students who register **after** the tuition/fee due date must make **immediate** payment arrangements in the Student Finance Office, Room 710
- Students who register late and have an unpaid account balance by the tuition/fee due date may experience:
  - \* Delays in financial aid processing.
  - \* \$25 monthly late charges on unpaid balance of account
  - \* Hold on class attendance
  - \* Unnecessary Stress!
- ***Please allow several weeks to process financial aid***

\* Students enrolled in 6 credit hours or more may be eligible for federal student loans or other financial assistance. The FAFSA must be filed and financial aid process complete. (*For more information please contact the Student Finance Office at (309) 624-9932*)
