Prior to joining the OSF HealthCare Ministry, Rogers spent many years in operations and maintains certification as a Medical Practice Executive. Rogers is skilled at building and growing strategic relationships and looks forward to further growing services at OSF Heart of Mary, including the Blessed Beginnings Birthing Center and the Cardiovascular Institute.

Rogers earned a Bachelor of Science degree from Illinois State University. She went on to pursue a Master of Education in early childhood special education administration from the University of Illinois and then a Master of Business Administration from Illinois State University.
